The CollegePresidentor designeshall be authorized to develop procedures to waive solicitation requirements in emergencies when there is an imminent threat to students, employees or publics afety, or in cases when necessary to prevent damaget to the facilities caused by an unexpected circumstance.

The college will not discriminate in the awarding of contracts on the basis of race, color, sex, religious affiliation, age, national origin, marital status, or any qualified handicap.

II. BIDS

Bidsshallbe requested as required by law by the District Boardfor any purchase exceeding Category Three asset forth in State Board of Education rule 6A-14.0734, the Florida Administrative Code, and applicable Florida Statute.
