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## I. PURPOSE

To establish the procedures necessary to ensure a safe and healthy working and learning environment.

## II. RESPONSIBILITY

The Executive Director of Campus Safety shall have responsibility for the monitoring and policy adherence if animals are on campus.

## III. BACKGROUND

In compliance with the above-cited Rule, and in consideration of the possible health and safety risks posed, the following guidelines shall apply to all property of Lake-Sumter State College (LSSC). Animals are not allowed on any LSSC property, including any buildings, grounds, or in a vehicle, except when needed for campus safety, for instruction, or for a

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- Accessibility Services (SAS). This allows appropriate documentation (vaccination records, etc.) to be on file with the SAS.
- c. Visitors may bring service animals on campus without registering them with SAS.
- d. All animals must be on a leash or be under the direct and positive control of the handler at all times while on campus.
